

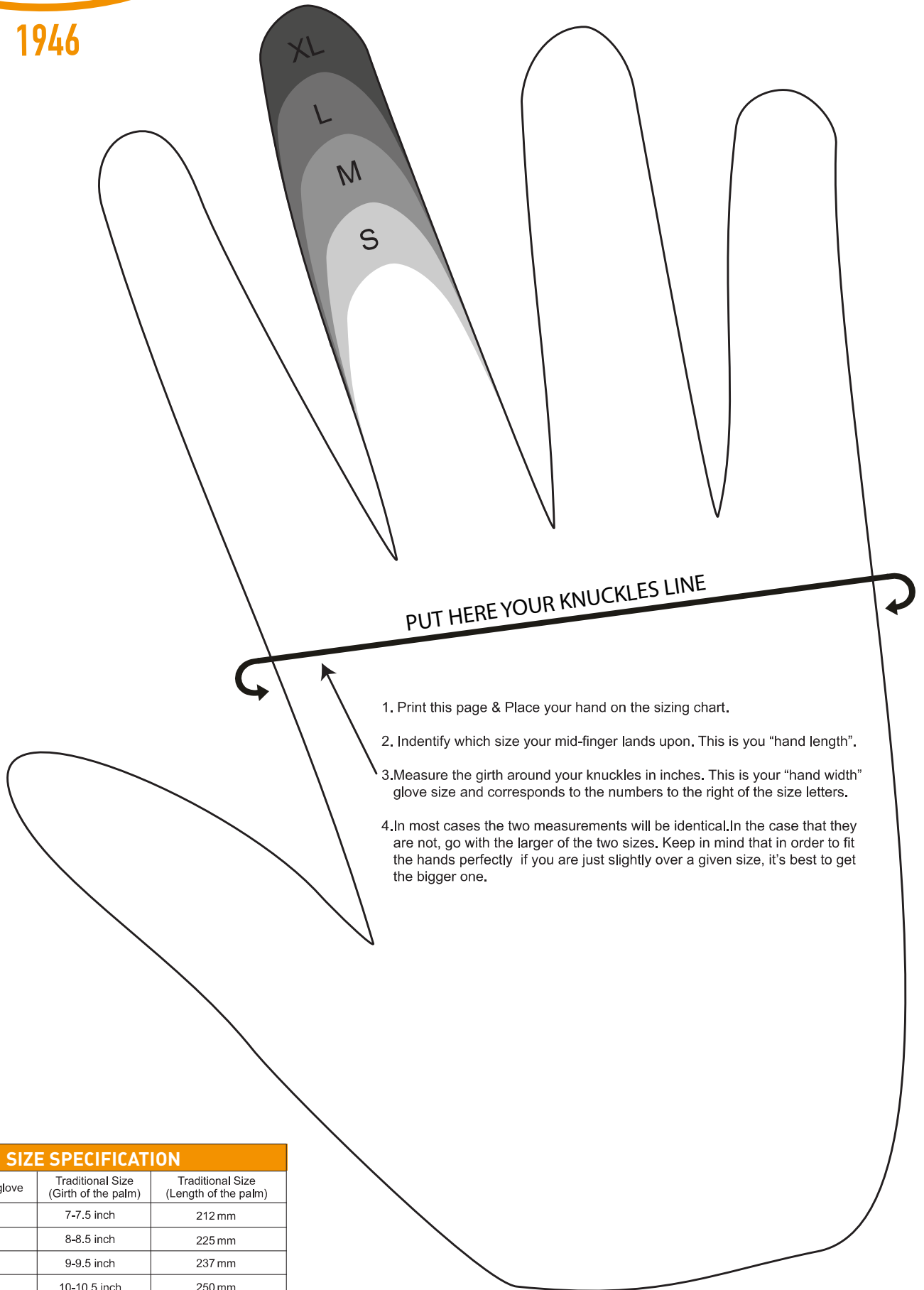

Rasor Safety Gloves

MEASURE CHART

1. Print this page & Place your hand on the sizing chart.
2. Identify which size your mid-finger lands upon. This is your "hand length".
3. Measure the girth around your knuckles in inches. This is your "hand width" glove size and corresponds to the numbers to the right of the size letters.
4. In most cases the two measurements will be identical. In the case that they are not, go with the larger of the two sizes. Keep in mind that in order to fit the hands perfectly if you are just slightly over a given size, it's best to get the bigger one.

S	7-7.5 inch	212 mm
M	8-8.5 inch	225 mm
L	9-9.5 inch	237 mm
XL	10-10.5 inch	250 mm
